Chief's Report

- 1. Bathrooms at Stn. 31: Hot water heaters have been installed.
- 2. **Wildland** The District is again making use of the DNR phase 1 (50/50 cost match) for wildland equipment.
- 3. **New Brush 312** is in service. In Fire Service tradition, it was pushed into the bay by the volunteers at the last training night.
- 4. **BNSF Foundation:** A check for \$6,000 was presented to the District by Courtney Wallace. The funds covered the cost of installing the lights and radio on the new Brush engine.
- 5. **The old Brush 312:** This vehicle is now at station 32 and renamed B-322. It is currently being stripped down for a new pump and foam educter system.
- 6. **Tender 314:** A new cabinet has been ordered to provide more storage on the tender, which is needed for gear when it is mobilized for extended periods.
- 7. Annual Report- The completed 2015 annual report was presented to the Commissioners.

Ongoing Business:

1. Personnel: Hiring a Chief

EXECUTIVE SESSION: —RCW 42.30.110(1)(g) To evaluate the qualifications of an applicant for public employment or to review the performance of a public employee. However, subject to RCW 42.30.140(4), discussion by a governing body of salaries, wages, and other conditions of employment to be generally applied within the agency shall occur in a meeting open to the public, and when a governing body elects to take final action hiring, setting the salary of an individual employee or class of employees, or discharging or disciplining an employee, that action shall be taken in a meeting open to the public.

Recessed public meeting for 15 minutes to 19:10.

Public entered the meeting room.

Reopened public meeting: 19:16

Review of hiring process: Chairman Zoller gave a brief review of the process to date. The Commissioners hired a consultant to help them through the process. They analyzed the qualifications desired in a chief, and the position was advertised locally and through on-line fire industry web sites. The first step had applicants send in a brief summary indicating their qualifications for the position. Selected individuals were then asked to submit an extensive application which included essay questions. After a technical review by a panel, six candidates were invited to attend an all-day assessment lab run by the consultant. The Assessment lab tested several management skills. Three individuals were then interviewed by a task force panel, a volunteer panel, and finally by the Commissioners.

Commissioner Zoller explained the next steps: A formal offer to the selected candidate would be announced. However, the offer requires a contract and at the time of the meeting the contract was still being reviewed by the attorney. So while the Commissioners know who they wish to offer the position to, they do not have the package of what they are going to offer. As soon as the contract is ready they will call a special meeting and confirm the offer.

Formal decision to offer the position of Chief: Commissioner Zoller announced that they would like to offer the position of Fire Chief to Wesley Long. Following the meeting the final candidates will be informed of the Commissioners' decision. Commissioner Zoller added that this process has been thorough and emotional, and they do not take it lightly.

Sverre Bakke representing the White Salmon Enterprise asked "Who is Wes Long?" Commissioner Zoller said he is currently a full time fire captain in SW Washington and had been a Fire Chief for a Fire Department very

similar to Fire District 3, that was located in another state. Commissioner Zoller noted that at this point they have not yet hired Mr. Long, they still need a contract to offer him, and for him to agree to the offer.

Surplus Vehicle. – The old brush unit has been declared surplus but has not been put up for bid yet. Roz is
working on a description that can be posted and hopes to be able to have the closed bid offers ready for
opening at the May 12th meeting.

New Business:

Annexation petition – Property owners on Lyons Road and 2 parcels owned by Mount Adams Orchards are proposed for annexation into the District. The properties are adjacent to the existing boundary. The petitions were presented to the Commissioners and a hearing will be scheduled at the May 12 commissioners meeting.

Good of the Order: None noted.
